Swartland - a region north of Cape Town, spanning an area between some of the Cape's most iconic towns. Darling is one of these, and we chose the Darling Presbyterian Church for our Swartland Chenin label. This church and the town of Darling are elegant in their simplicity. The fruit is sourced from the Swartland from granitic outcrops on the foothills of the Paardeberg.

TASTING NOTES

Crisp, with floral and fruit aromas, followed by a bouquet of baked lemons and honeydew, enticing citrus rind on the palate, smooth, long, dry finish. The Church 2022 Chenin perfectly supplements salt and pepper squid, or any fresh seafood.
