Our main purpose is to offer the wine world something a little different. In the spirit of collaboration, we partnered with our friend Joseph Dhafana of Mosi Wines and Spirits to create this blend. Tongai Joseph Dhafana is a refugee turned winemaker, an awardwinning Sommelier, a philanthropist, Mosi Wines and Spirits owner, and a wine judge.

The Cabernet Franc is at an altitude of 250m in the Bottelary ward, the Merlot from the east-facing slope of the Simonsberg ridge, the Petit Verdot is at 275m above sea-level in the Bottelary ward and the Cabernet Sauvignon is planted on various sites within the Bottelary, Helderberg and Polkadraai.

TASTING NOTES

The medium bodied Bordeaux styled blend displays an enticing, dark, attractive plum coloured wine, with dark fruit aromas of plum, cassis and blackberry, balanced with pencil shavings and vanilla pod. Mosi 2021 has a firm acidity and a very pleasant tannic structure that will ensure good aging potential.
