ELGIN PINOT NOIR

Meticulously crafted with grapes from one of the highest altitude vineyards of the prestigious Elgin wine region - this light-bodied red is loved for its earthy fruit and spice flavours. Like the mist that lingers over the mountains, these flavours are accentuated by a long, smooth and soft tannin finish.

TASTING NOTES

Bright, pale garnet, beautiful aromas of cherries and strawberry jam, floral notes, and hints of honey, the Myst 2022 allures one to experience a classic styled Pinot Noir. Good acidity and wood will mature it to its full potential. Cellar for a few years, allow to breathe after opening, and enjoy with pork tenderloin.

VIN TAGE CONDITIONS

The grapes are sourced from one of the highest altitude vineyards of the prestigious Elgin wine region.

VINIFICATION

Myst is grown on Bokkeveld shale soils with high clay content on a south-facing slope. It is densely planted and is hand-harvested mid-Feb. Only native yeast and bacteria is used during vinification. Two pumpovers per day. The wine only spends two weeks on the skins to preserve the vibrancy. Mostly 300L barrels - cooperage including Chassin, Francois Freres, Gillet and Cavin - are used for maturation of 10 months.
